

MetroParks Trails Challenge

Your Five Rivers MetroParks locations are home to 160 miles of paved and natural surface trails for hiking, cycling, mountain biking and horseback riding. The greater Dayton region is home to more than 340 miles of paved trails - the nation's largest paved trail network - and 270 miles of river corridor. The new **MetroParks Trails Challenge** is a fun way to explore them.
